Tribunal: Support of FCA, FSB, TSC, Small Business Commissioner position statement to be released 01.11.18 lawyer drafting proposals for an arbitration tribunal to deal with legacy cases The Group will now accept an ad-hoc compensation scheme. Insolvency: meeting with BEIS policy advisor for progress update on governments corporate insolvency framework focus area for next 6/7 to get report into BEIS –

- legislation involves corporate governance piece training for directors as lenders complain of lack of financial education.
